## Vibratory Feeder Bowl Builder

Experience Required

### SUMMARY

Fabricates and assembles parts orienting feeder bowls according to blueprints, manuals, design memos, sketches, and past knowledge of feeder bowl construction

**ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may be assigned.**

- Analyzes data to determine the proper construction requirements for the system.
- Checks customer part dimensions; relation of one part to another if there are multiple parts being handled.
- Prepares system layout.
- Constructs the feeder bowl; using various hand tools, saws, welders, and grinders.
- Bench inspects bowl to ensure unit is built to high quality requirements, including simplicity of design, cleanup, smoothness of lines, and meets all customer and company requirements.
- Inspects assemblies according to specifications on engineering drawings and accompanying documentation.

This position has no supervisory responsibilities.

### QUALIFICATIONS
